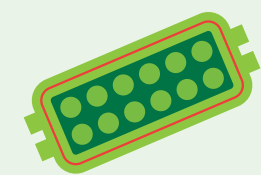

LED Lights

- **97%** of lights in common areas replaced with LED bulbs
- LEDs offer the same brightness, use half the power and last twice as long compared to fluorescent bulbs, and they can be recycled too



Rooftop Solar Panels

- **256** of 275 blocks installed
- Savings of about **23 million kg** of CO₂ emissions



Smart and Sustainable Tengah

Tengah in Hong Kah North will be the first HDB town to be fully integrated with its surrounding natural environment.

The Biophilic Town Framework emphasises a nature-centric community with nature at its doorstep, complemented by a car-free Town Centre.

Smart technologies, including solar panels, centralised cooling, environmental simulations and a waste conveyance system, make green living accessible.

Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve

Sungei Buloh Wetland Reserve, Singapore's first ASEAN Heritage Park, spans 202 hectares and boasts a diverse ecosystem of mangroves, mudflats, ponds and forests. This haven of rich biodiversity is vital for migratory birds and showcases myriad flora and fauna.

Sembcorp Tengah Floating Solar Farm



Singapore's first major floating solar system on the Tengah Reservoir. With 122,000 solar panels across 10 solar floating panel islands, it can power about 16,000 four-room HDB flats annually.



MRT Seats Upcycling

Seats upcycled from retired MRT trains were placed in CCK Town as part of the sustainability initiative, Action for Green Towns, a collaboration between SMRT and 15 PAP Town Councils.

Electric Vehicle (EV) Charging Points

With the shift to electric cars – which generate 50% less carbon emissions than internal combustion engine cars – more EV charging points are being introduced in HDB carparks. CCK Town currently has 11 such points, with more in the pipeline.

Learn from CCK Town's Eco-Champions

Congratulations to our residents, Eleen Koay, Ting Siew Khim and Ng Chee Wee, on winning CCK Town's Eco-Contest! They showed us how to incorporate the 3Rs of Reduce, Reuse & Recycle (3Rs) in our everyday lives.

"Make new dining chair seats and covers from leather of old sofa."

Eleen Koay, Brickland

Raised by a carpenter father and seamstress mother, Eleen learned hands-on skills from watching them tinker with things. In 2023, noticing her worn-out sofa and dining chairs, she had an inspiration. "The sofa's springs were broken, but its leather was intact," the 33-year-old recalled. She proposed using the sofa's leather to refresh the dining chairs.

One weekend, the family removed the chairs' old fabric and repurposed the sofa's leather into new seats. By evening, Eleen had revitalised six dining chairs. She even crafted baby pillows and bolsters for her kids using leftover leather.

She said, "Had the sofa's wood been better, we would've made other furniture. With the right tools, the metal frame could've been reused too."

In Eleen's family, when something is broken, they assess to see if it can be repaired or repurposed. For example, her sister turned her old car tyres into a side table. "It is wasteful to just throw things away because everything is so expensive," Eleen remarked.

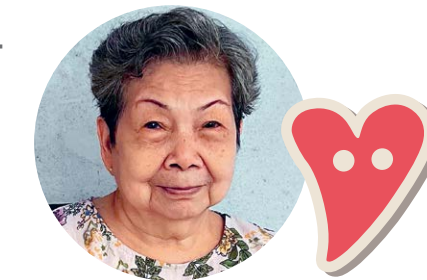
New Sheltered Drop-Off Points

A Day Out at Sembcorp Tengeh Floating Solar Farm

15 lucky CCK Town residents got to visit Sembcorp Tengeh Floating Solar Farm (pictured below) in November 2023, under an exclusive collaboration between CCK Town Council and Sembcorp. This farm, one of the largest of its kind in the world, is in our CCK Town.

It was an eye-opening experience for the residents to see this farm up close and learn how it harnesses energy enough to power up some 16,000 four-room flats for one year!



Keat Hong resident Leong Ai Kuen felt a strong sense of pride in learning how much Singapore has invested in the green energy space, and that one of the world's largest inland floating solar farms is located in Singapore.

As the farm is not open to the public, Keat Hong resident Sreeraj Choorakad said he was glad he managed to snag a seat on the tour. He also encouraged everyone to be interested in sustainability because we need to ensure that the Earth is still around for the next generations to come.

For Delfinn Tan, a resident of Hong Kah North, it was heartening to know the panels did not have as large an impact on the ecology of the reservoir as she thought they would.

At the end of the visit, Delfinn summed up the experience for her fellow visitors: "This was a unique opportunity for residents to come here and see one of the largest floating farms in Singapore. We are all happy and pleased to see Singapore doing more and more in the renewable energy space."
